On a mountain that nobody has ever climbed there is a cabin buried in the ice. It has no doors or windows. The walls are made of something we cannot cut. There are two bodies, one with a stab wound, and a puddle of water mixed with blood. There is a network of black fibers wrapped around the organs.

We will develop a library of gradients which can be combined to reproduce any segment of this scene. Although the pigments that we use to register light distributions have photosynthetic origins, they are not used for photosynthesis itself but for tracking down nth-order photosynthetic potentials. Depending on your physical scale and requirements, you may apply a greater or lesser number of abstraction filters. Remain flexible and the independent elements will reveal themselves. We have nothing but time
